

## Gladwin Township Board Meeting

May 21, 2025

Meeting called to order at 6:30 by Supervisor Weaver. All board members present except Doug Ritchie. Pledge to the flag. Other people present were Corey Cuddie, Jeremy Cuddie, John Vanderhagen, Keith Fisher, Alan Donaldson.

Motion by Jodie Klamer seconded by Jennifer Slabic to approve the minutes from the April meeting. M/C. Treasurer's report given and the general account is \$347,135.02 and Member First Credit Union Savings Account \$6,358.62 and Member's First Credit Union CD is \$38,676.87. Motion by Kristie Simrau seconded by Jennifer Slabic to approve the treasurer's report as presented. M/C. The clerk presented the bills to be paid in the amount of \$16,649.42. Motion by Jennifer Slabic seconded by Jodie Klamer to pay the bills in the amount of \$16,649.42. M/C.

Alan Donaldson, County Commissioner was present and gave report. Talked about the county master plan committee and master plan for the parks. The parks committee meets on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Tuesday every month. Street fest on July 12<sup>th</sup>.

Corey Cuddie presented a property split for Keith Edick. Splitting the 75 acre parcel into two parcels. The split meets all the requirements for the State of Michigan and for the Gladwin County zoning. The request will split 75 acres in half. One half will contain the home at 2016 Nickless Road and the out buildings and the other half is vacant land. Motion by Jodie Klamer seconded by Jennifer Slabic for Resolution number 25-17 for property split for Keith Edick at 2016 Nickless Road 75 acres split into two parcels one with the home and out buildings and the other vacant land. Roll call Klamer- yes, Simrau- yes; Weaver- yes; Slabic- yes. Ayes carried M/C.

Jodie was commenting on road millage stating the board can levy up to 3 mill without a vote of the people. The board had discussion regarding a road millage. Jodie also had someone ask her about mosquito spray for the township.

Cemetery report 2 cremations Dawn West and Donald Hale. There were two mowings and spring cleanup done. Jennifer questioned about getting a metal detector to find the markers in the newly surveyed area. She will get estimates.

The gravel projects for the year will be on Youngs Road the first mile of from M-18; Kern Road from Wagarville South to Ridge and McClure Cemetery Road. \$38,250. Motion by Kristie Simrau seconded by Jodie Klamer to approve the gravel requests for Youngs Road, McClure Cemetery Road and Kern Road. M/C.

Supervisor gave everyone the blight ordinance and will look at issuing tickets down on Parkway.

Public comment - Reminder to everyone to complete the survey for the county master plan.
