

**Gladwin Township Board Meeting  
December 17, 2025**

Meeting called to order at 6:30 by Supervisor Weaver. Pledge to the flag. All board members present. There were a lot of people in attendance. Motion by Doug Ritchie seconded by Jodie Klamer to accept the November minutes. M/C Treasurer's report general account \$301,120.76 and money market account \$46,067.48. Motion by Kristie Simrau seconded by Jennifer Slabic to receive and file the treasurer's report. M/C. Motion by Jodie Klamer seconded by Doug Ritchie to pay the bills in the amount of \$26,060.04. M/C. Alan Donaldson, county commissioner was present and gave report.

Kristie Simrau made a motion for 2026 Poverty Exemption Resolution number 25-21 to set the Poverty Exemption according to the Federal Poverty Income Guidelines. Roll call vote Klamer-yes; Simrau- yes; Weaver, yes; Slabic, yes; Ritchie, yes; 5 ayes 0 nays. Motion carried.

Corey Cuddie, Assessor presented a property split for Rollin Greer and Kim Greer on 998 Hoffman Road, Gladwin, MI. The request is to split 2 two-acre parcels and 2 one-acre parcels along McClure Cemetery Road from a 37 acre parcel containing a home and farm buildings. The home and outbuildings will have road frontage on Hoffman Road. The survey will be held in the clerk's records. Corey recommended the property split and the split meets the State of Michigan requirements and conforms to the Gladwin County Zoning. Motion for Resolution # 25-22 by Kristie Simrau seconded by Jodie Klamer to approve the property split for Rollin and Kim Greer. Roll call Klamer-yes; Simrau-yes; Weaver-yes; Slabic-yes; Ritchie-yes. Ayes caried Motion carried.

Nothing to report on the cemetery. Fireboard meeting minutes read by the clerk.

The supervisor commented on the request for the township to pay \$20,000 on pavement on Old M-30 would be our cost per the road commission. The board will discuss in the budget workshop. The township board will have a budget workshop January 7, 2026 @ 6:00 pm.

Doug Ritchie had some questions regarding the solar farms in the county for the commissioner. Doug questioned whether he knew of any health concerns from the solar panels? Doug asked how much money the county received from the permit for solar farms? There were other questions and concerns from the people present at the meeting. Good conversations and concerns from the Grout Township Solar Operation and people present from that area.
